



Foster-to-Adopt (F2A) Job Description

This position is an adjunct to the Foster Position and incorporates all the requirements of a Foster home. This is not an on-going position but a single-case opportunity for both the KBTF and the potential adopting family to bring a rescue into their home, evaluate and care for the dog.

Duties:

All requirements for the Foster Family apply as does responsibility to keep the RC, or RD, informed as to the health, behavior and assessment of the dog.
If at any time during the dog's residence with the F2A family, the family decides the dog is not a match for them, they must advise the RC of their decision.
The F2A family must agree to maintain the dog in their home until another suitable Foster home or situation can be found for the dog and they will assist in the arrangements and transport of the dog to another destination.
Should an emergency arise where the F2A family cannot keep the dog in their home, they will work with the RC to find a suitable kennel arrangement for the temporary care of the dog. They must also agree to assist in the arrangements and transport of the dog to another destination from the kennel.
The F2A family will have a pre-determined period (to be determined by the RC and/or RD) to decide if the dog is a good fit for their family and consult with the RC, or RD, for advice and assistance.
The F2A family reports to the RC.
Other duties as assigned
